Subject: Information sought under RTI Act regarding details of officers/officials who were granted ACP as per their eligibility – Regarding.

Sir,

I am to refer to your application dated 26.05.12 under RTI Act on the subject mentioned above. In this connection, it is informed that Photo Division does not maintain the information in the form sought by you.

2. In this context, your reference is invited to section 7(9) of the RTI Act which provides that 'an information shall ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought unless it would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question. DOP&T OM No. 1/4/2009-IR dated 05.10.2009 further provide that the Public Information Officer is not required to create information.

3. Since the information sought by you is not kept in the desired form, the Public Authority will have to collect and create such information from records of last 14 years in the form desired by you which will disproportionately divert the scarce resources of the public authority. It is, therefore, not found feasible to supply requisite information as requested for by you.

4. However, if you need information about any specific case, you may cite the same and the information, if available, will be provided to you.
