Subject: Information sought under Right to Information Act, 2005 regarding introduction of reservation for physically handicapped person in post filled by promotion within Group 'C'.

Please refer to your application dated 22.06.2012 on the above subject forwarded by Under Secretary (MC) & CPIO, Ministry of I&B vide their letter dated 25.06.2012.


2. The point-wise information to the questions mentioned in your letter is detailed below:

[a, b & c] The instruction contained in the DoP&T's OM No.36035/1/89-ESTT (SCT), dated 20.11.1989 regarding introduction of 3% reservation for Physically Handicapped Person in post filled by promotion within Group 'C' was implemented by the Photo Division. However due to small strength of Group 'C' posts, the vacancies arising in Group 'C' post in a single recruitment year were very less. Therefore a post for filling up by promotion with a person with physically disability could not be identified under the 3% prescribed quota. However, two person with physically disability (HH) available in the feeder grade were promoted in the 1990.

Since, 100 points roster for effecting reservation for the persons with disabilities w.e.f. 1996 as envisaged in DoP&T's OM No.36035/3/2004-Estt.(Res), dated 29.12.2005 read with DoP&T's OM No.36035/8/2003-Estt.(Res), dated 26.04.2006 has not been prepared at this stage, therefore, information regarding point No.(b) and (c) of your application is not available at present.
